#### Spotlight on : Confirmation

**Confirmation** is a special church service in which you choose to confirm the promises that were made when you were baptized, to turn away from sin and to trust **God**. Being confirmed is a sign that you commit your life to **following Jesus** Christ; it is about being part of the local and worldwide **Christian family**.

In the Confirmation service, a bishop lays their hands on your head and asks God to give you the strength to **live God's way** for the rest of your life, and the church promises to **support and pray** for you.



It is a very joyful occasion, marking a fresh start in your life. There is no right age for a person to be confirmed – you could be in your **teens** or in your **nineties**! If you have not been baptized already, you can be both baptized and confirmed in the same service. For some people, Confirmation is also the first time they share in bread and wine at Holy Communion.
