CHILDREN'S CHURCH : Beth and Tamsin are now running **Children's Church** every Sunday at 10am,

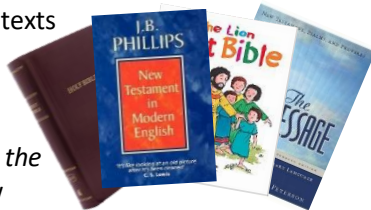
- **children and parents start in church, then children enjoy a separate session in the hall before returning to church to share what they've been doing. All school age children welcome**

Spotlight on : Bible reading

There are many different **translations** available of the Bible – the traditional *Authorised Version*, more conversationally worded texts such as the *J. B. Phillips New Testament*, or freer modern translations like *The Message* or *Word on the Street*, to name but a few examples, and children's bibles too. Some work best when read aloud, while in others the rhythms and turns of phrase make them easier to remember, or the modern words give fresh insights.



There's also a wide choice of day by day **notes** to read alongside the Bible, to introduce us to the context in which passages were written and help us understand the timeless message, such as *New Daylight* or *Guidelines* from the Bible Reading Fellowship; these daily notes give helpful comments on a bible passage, and a relevant thought or prayer.



And then there are **combined commentaries** with both a unique and accessible translation of a complete book of the Bible and comments upon each section from the translator, like William Barclay's *Daily Study Bible* or the more recent *For Everyone* series by Tom Wright.

What Else?

For families C.a.f.e. :

Children's Church C.a.f.e.: fun ways for school-aged children to find out more about Jesus each week, while parents are at 10am service (*starts and ends in church*)

Rainbow Tots: short service in church on 1st Monday each month for toddlers and their carers.
