## 25<sup>th</sup> January : The conversion of St. Paul

One of the special days we celebrate in January is the Conversion of St. Paul. Saul (as he was then known) was convinced that we are saved by sticking rigidly to the tenets of the Law, and was therefore violently opposed to the new teachings of Jesus and to all who followed them. It took a blinding encounter with the risen Jesus to open



his eyes that we are saved not by laws or by efforts of our own but by God's gift. Saul became Paul, his life transformed from

persecuting the Good News to sharing it. And although the revelation and the transformation came about through a blinding flash, it took Paul a lifetime of commitment to follow his new calling.

The same Lord who met with St. Paul on the road to Damascus meets with us every day, continually and little by little to re-make us into His image.

Dear Father,

Like Saul, we so often cling to a wrong notion of what the life of faith involves.

Forgive us, and set us back on the right path.

Shock us out of our rigidity, intolerance or complacency;

open our eyes to see ourselves as we really are; transform our hearts so that, like St. Paul, we can live each day sharing the Good News of your love.

#### For everyone:

**Said communion:** short, said service, 8.30am Sundays

**Parish Communion:** 10am Sundays (not 3<sup>rd</sup> of month), sometimes sung liturgy, sometimes said with hymns

**Family Service (followed by Communion):** 10am, special Sundays – watch out for details of dates.

**Sunday Morning with St Peter's:** 10am 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of month, an informal mix of words, music and reflections

**Evensong:** 4pm (6pm in summer) 1<sup>st</sup> Sunday each month (sometimes Songs of Praise instead of Evensong)

**Healing service:** 7.00pm (mostly) 1<sup>st</sup> Thursday each month

**FOSPA:** tea/cakes/company, 2-5pm summer Sundays

**Men's Social:** chat together, 1<sup>st</sup> Monday of month, 7.30pm at The Fleece (*not every month - check for dates*)

**Wulferans:** adult mixed fellowship with varied programme of meetings and entertainment. 1<sup>st</sup> Tuesday each month. Contact Wendy Croft 01943 830 400

**Choir:** all welcome, practices on Friday evenings 2-3 times a month. Contact Judith Idle 01943 830508

**Music Group:** instruments and singers lead music in church once a month.
