## Spotlight on : Celtic spirituality

St Peter's often holds a **Celtic-style Communion** at 10am when there's a **fifth Sunday** in the month, reflecting the emphases of Celtic spirituality.

The blessings carved on our stone obelisk and window outside the hall come from this Celtic spirituality.

**Celtic spirituality** grew from rural Irish roots in the early centuries AD, different from the more urban Romanised traditions of Christianity. There was a strong emphasis on living in **community** – as a reflection of the community of God represented by the **Trinity** of Father, Son and Holy Spirit – and on **hospitality**, not only welcoming God into their hearts each day but also welcoming others because that person could be Christ. God was seen as **in everything**, so all things and all parts of life were sacred, and to be included **in prayer**, with a special reverence and care for the **created world**. **Music and arts** were embraced as a way of passing on wisdom about a **way of life** following Jesus. **Prayer** was a weapon in the everyday reality of **spiritual warfare**. **Time was sacred**, and time spent with God was of prime importance, **being not doing**; the past, present and future were all linked to **God's Now** - yesterday, today and for ever.

Much for us to ponder during Celtic Communion.

### For everyone:

**Said communion:** short, said service, 8.30am Sundays

**Parish Communion:** 10am Sundays (not 3<sup>rd</sup> of month), sometimes sung liturgy, sometimes said with hymns

**Family Service (followed by Communion):** 10am, special Sundays – watch out for details of dates.

**Sunday Morning with St Peter's:** 10am 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of month, an informal mix of words, music and reflections

**Evensong:** 6pm (*4pm in winter*) 1<sup>st</sup> Sunday each month (sometimes Songs of Praise instead of Evensong)

**Healing service:** 7.00pm, (mostly) 1<sup>st</sup> Thursday each month

**FOSPA:** tea/cakes/company, 2-5pm summer Sundays

**Men's Social:** chat together, monthly (*check for dates*), 7.30pm at The Fleece

**Wulpherans:** adult mixed fellowship with varied programme of meetings and entertainment. 1<sup>st</sup> Tuesday each month. Contact Wendy Croft 01943 830 400

**Choir:** all welcome, practices on Friday evenings 2-3 times a month. Contact Judith Idle 01943 830508

**Music Group:** instruments and singers lead music in church once a month.
