

## Spotlight on : **Palm Sunday**

**Palm Sunday** is when we remember that Jesus came into Jerusalem to people cheering him and waving **palm branches** like flags of triumph, but that the week was to end with this same crowd calling for – and getting – his **Crucifixion**. It's a day to face the fact that it wasn't just "them" – it's still us who give easy assent when the going is good, but shrink away when things get tough and we begin to realise what the cost will be for us – better let someone else pay it instead. And God did – and does; he knows the truth of us, and pays the price of it, offering **forgiveness** and new life.

Now to the gate of my Jerusalem,  
The seething holy city of my heart,  
The saviour comes. But will I welcome him?  
Oh crowds of easy feelings make a start;  
They raise their hands, get caught up in the singing,  
And think the battle won. Too soon they'll find  
The challenge, the reversal he is bringing  
Changes their tune. I know what lies behind  
The surface flourish that so quickly fades;  
Self-interest, and fearful guardedness,  
The hardness of the heart, its barricades,  
And at the core, the dreadful emptiness  
Of a perverted temple. Jesus come  
Break my resistance and make me your home.

May our **Palm Crosses** remind us throughout the year of what we learned about ourselves and about God on Palm Sunday, and may this Lent culminate for us in acknowledging our sins, accepting forgiveness and **starting afresh with God**.

### **For everyone:**

**Said communion:** short, said service, 8.30am Sundays

**Parish Communion:** 10am Sundays (not 3<sup>rd</sup> of month), sometimes sung liturgy, sometimes said with hymns

**Family Service (followed by Communion):** 10am, special Sundays – watch out for details of dates.

**Sunday Morning with St Peter's:** 10am 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of month, an informal mix of words, music and reflections

**Evensong:** 4pm (*6pm in summer*) 1<sup>st</sup> Sunday each month (sometimes Songs of Praise instead of Evensong)

**Healing service:** 7.00pm, (mostly) 1<sup>st</sup> Thursday each month

**FOSPA:** tea/cakes/company, 2-5pm summer Sundays

**Men's Social:** chat together, 1<sup>st</sup> Monday of month, 7.30pm at The Fleece (*not every month - check for dates*)

**Wulpherans:** adult mixed fellowship with varied programme of meetings and entertainment. 1<sup>st</sup> Tuesday each month. Contact Wendy Croft 01943 830 400

**Choir:** all welcome, practices on Friday evenings 2-3 times a month. Contact Judith Idle 01943 830508

**Music Group:** instruments and singers lead music in church once a month.
