Spotlight on A walk around the church

There are two types of guide on offer to help you as you walk around our beautiful church. One is historical, taking you on a journey through the ages from the first



Christian worship here in Anglo Saxon times round a carved stone cross, through the first church building, and explaining the many changes and developments there have been across the years. As you look round, you can learn about this history from the printed leaflet, or on a summer Sunday

afternoon you can listen to the recorded spoken version tracing changes in the Christian community here; or, if you can't visit in person, you can read and listen to the church history on our website.

The other guide takes a different approach. Called

"Look around you", it's like a mini pilgrimage, asking what **spiritual** insights the different parts of the building can give us as we spend time in quiet reflection



at St. Peter's. Try it for yourself, and take a copy home with you to continue your meditation.

As you enter the building, you become part of the history of this place where prayers have been said for millennia. Whichever guide you choose (or none), if you come from afar or live in the village, whether you've never set foot in a church before or you worship here each week, take the opportunity to say your own prayer here, and may the time you spend here refresh you physically, emotionally and spiritually.
