## Spotlight on **Foodbank Collections**

On the first Sunday of every month, St. Peter's acts as foodbank collection point. But what happens to your donations of **non-perishable food and toiletries** once you leave them here in the porch? Well, first they are loaded into cars and taken to the **Salvation Army Community Centre** in Keighley. There, staff and volunteers sort and pack the items, making them ready for distribution as **emergency 3-day food provision** for those in crisis. Everyone who receives a food pack has been referred to the Salvation Army for help by professionals such as GPs and social workers.

**Sunday Morning with St Peter's:** 10am 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of month, an informal mix of words, music and reflections rather than traditional parish communion

**Evensong:** 6pm (*4pm in winter*) 1<sup>st</sup> Sunday each month

**Healing service:** 7.00pm 1<sup>st</sup> Thursday each month

**FOSPA:** tea/cakes/company, 2-5pm summer Sundays

**Wulpherans:** adult mixed fellowship with varied programme of meetings and entertainment. 1<sup>st</sup> Tuesday each month. Contact Wendy Croft 01943 830 400

**Music Group:** instruments and singers lead music in church once a month.
