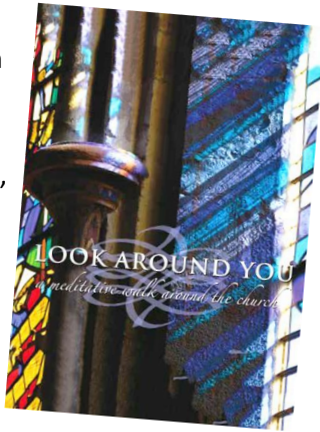
Spotlight on : **Looking around**

If you've been into St. Peter's church building many times, you've probably spent some time learning about its **history** by reading the informative leaflet to be found at the back of church. (And if not, that's a treat in store for you!) But have you ever taken time to complete not the historical tour but the **meditative walk** around the church, as outlined in the small booklet entitled "*Look around you*"?

It's rather like a **mini spiritual pilgrimage**, with stopping points at different places in the building such as the door, the windows or the font, to reflect on their significance for our inner life, with each location having a few words of explanation, a brief relevant passage from the Bible to think about and a short prayer. Try it!

Dear Father, may this be a place and a community where strangers feel welcome and the lost find hope; may our lives be anchored in the rock of your deep love, which we receive ourselves and share with others; in the beauty of this place and of the lives we see around us, may we glimpse the beauty of heaven, and find in you our eternal home. Amen

What Else?

For families **C.a.f.e.** :

Children's Church **C.a.f.e.**: fun ways for school-aged children to find out more about Jesus each Sunday (in term-time) at 10am (*starts and ends in church*)

Messy Church **C.a.f.e.**: a different kind of church especially for families with activity-based time, food, songs & fun, 2nd Sunday each month at 4pm.

St. Peter's Playgroup **C.a.f.e.**: happy times for babies, toddlers and their carers every Monday (in term-time) at 9.30am.

Family Service with Communion **C.a.f.e.**: relaxed service for the whole church family with child-friendly words, music and involvement – watch out for details of dates.

Monthly Podcast: a mix of more contemporary music and reflections around a theme, with interesting conversations between Mark and local people

For everyone:

Said communion: short, said service, 8.30am Sundays

Parish Communion: 10am Sundays (not 3rd of month), sometimes sung liturgy, sometimes said with hymns

Family Service (followed by Communion): 10am, special Sundays – watch out for details of dates.

Sunday Morning with St Peter's: 10am 3rd Sunday of month, an informal mix of words, music and reflections

Evensong: 6pm (*4pm in winter*) 1st Sunday each month (sometimes Songs of Praise instead of Evensong)

Healing service: 7.00pm, 1st Thursday each month

FOSPA: tea/cakes/company, 2-4pm summer Sundays (*check Facebook and website for latest news of dates*)

Men's Social: chat together, 1st Monday each month 7.30pm at The Fleece

Wulpherans: fellowship with varied programme, 1st Tuesday each month. Contact Wendy Croft 01943 830 400

Choir: all welcome, practices on Fridays 7pm 2-3 times a month. Contact Judith Idle 01943 830508

Music Group: instruments/singers, some Sundays 10am.
